## Entry Information

### AGILITY ONLY: ENTRIES MAY USE THE AKC ONLINE ENTRY SERVICE

Go to the AKC Agility Online Entry Services home page at [www.akc.org/AgilityEntry](http://www.akc.org/AgilityEntry) and follow the instructions there to use your 'My AKC' account to enter this event online. . (Please note that AKC charges a small processing fee for online entries.) During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be as follows: 25% online entries (165 runs) and 75% paper entries (495 runs). If either form of entry (paper or online) has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly.

\*\*\*Hand deliveries will not be accepted during the first 24 hours after the trial's opening.\*\*\*\*

- Limit: 10 entries per envelope. One entry = one dog. Envelopes containing more than 10 entries will be returned.
- Paper entries received within 24 hours of the opening date & time must: 1) include postage or be metered; 2) be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS & DHL. If above conditions are not met, the entries are not valid and must be returned to sender.

## SIMPLIFIED AGILITY JUMP HEIGHT CARD PROCESS

It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in, unless specifically requested.

**NEW ENTRY FORM:** The new entry form has a section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog needs to be measured. Please check the box if your dog needs to be measured so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*.

All agility dogs are required to have an Official Jump Height Card/Valid yellow form and exhibitors must be able to present it at any time during the trial **upon request**. All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form **must** be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. **If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.**

- You must waive signature requirements when using services that utilize signature verifications.
- All entries must be submitted on official AKC agility entry forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopies of entry form will be accepted only if legible and official AKC size.
- Entries will not be accepted without signature, fees and reverse side of entry form with agreement signed, nor will credit cards or faxed entries be accepted with paper entries.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry; no refund for duplicate entries. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25 service charge for returned checks.
- Refunds will not be made for less than \$5.00.

## AGILITY WAIT LIST -REFUND POLICY

DOTC is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of twenty-five (25) entries will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to the trial closing date as listed on the front of this Premium. Any entries withdrawn that are received by 6:00 pm the Monday prior to the first day of the trial will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by 6:00 pm the Monday prior to the first day of the trial will receive a full refund.

## **Exhibitor Information** Applies to All Events

- Pinch collars, prong collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited on trial grounds.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.
- Running order will be determined by computer-generated random draw. Handlers with multiple dogs in one class will have those dogs separated as much as possible.
- All Obedience and Rally classes will be arranged in jump height order so remember to include jump height on entry form.
- All dogs present *must* be on leash or confined in crates when not being judged or at the warm up jump.
- Puppies under six months of age are NOT allowed in the trial site.
- Free parking is available for exhibitors. Park at your own risk.
- Agility exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group. This is prohibited in Obedience and Rally.
- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all the obstacles safely.
- The Club and the Trial Secretary have no obligation or responsibility to provide a public address system or stewards to call or locate dogs that are not present at the ring when required. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the gate when it is their turn to run.
- The Club and the Trial Facility assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.
- Exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. No refund of entry fees will be made.
- Dogs may not be left overnight at the trial site.

### **SET-UP**

Exhibitors are allowed to set up beginning at 7:00 am on Saturday morning. THERE WILL BE NO SCHEDULED SET UP ON FRIDAY.

### **TRIAL HOURS**

The trial grounds will be open at 7:00 am. Self-service check-in will begin at 7 am, and judging will begin no earlier than 8 a.m. Exact running order will be determined after entries close and will be provided in the Judging Program.

### **AGILITY AND RALLY - WALK-THRUS & WARM-UPS**

Handlers are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. Each walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class/jump height.

### **AGILITY RING DIMENSIONS & SURFACE**

The agility rings are approximately: Standard-90' X 100'; JWW- 90' X 90'. The trial will be held indoors on packed dirt in a non-climate-controlled (neither air-conditioned nor heated) arena. This set of trials uses electronic timers.

**Refund Policy**

- Entry fees will be refunded if an entry is pulled before the closing date and time.
- No refunds will be made for any entry pulled after the closing date.
- The club will provide full refunds less \$5 per class entered for bitches in season. Veterinary verification in writing must be submitted to the Trial Secretary no later than 30 minutes before the start of the trials. Refunds will be mailed after the trial.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge, barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee, is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly or if a trial cannot open or be completed.
- Entry fees will not be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Refunds will not be made for less than \$5.00.

**AWARDS**

**AGILITY:**

**Ribbons/Rosettes:** Rosettes will be awarded to the 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> place dog in each class in each jump height. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs must qualify to receive placement ribbons. A plush dog toy valued at \$3 to \$5 will be awarded for 1st place in each jump height.

**OBEDIENCE:**

A qualifying score is required for all prizes. A qualifying ribbon will be given to each dog attaining a qualifying score. First through fourth place ribbons will be awarded in each class. First through fourth places in each class will receive a dog toy. Highest Scoring Dog in the Regular Classes will receive a blue & gold rosette. Highest Combined Score in Open and Utility will receive a blue & green rosette.

**RALLY:**

A qualifying score is required for all prizes. A qualifying ribbon will be given to each dog attaining a qualifying score. First through fourth place ribbons will be awarded in each class. First through fourth places in each class will receive a dog toy.

**Placement Ribbons/Rosettes in all events will be the following color:**

First Place .....	Blue
Second Place .....	Red
Third Place .....	Yellow
Fourth Place .....	White

**MOVE UPS**

**Agility & Rally:** Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for a title, provided that the request is received in writing by the Trial Secretary, no later than 6 pm on the Monday preceding the event. Day-to-day (trial-to-trial for Rally) move ups are allowed provided the Trial Secretary is notified at the show site, in writing within 30 minutes of the last dog completing the course. Forms will be available at the show site.

**Obedience move-ups are regulated by Section 16a of the Obedience Regulations, which state:** "Move-ups may be approved, provided the next level class (e. g. Novice to Open) and judge is available and the class has not reached its limit."

**Email pre-trial move-up requests to the Trial Secretary at [ntxagility@verizon.net](mailto:ntxagility@verizon.net)** No form is necessary, but please include the following information: The event you are requesting for a move-up, your name, your dog's call name, and the class and jump height to which you would like your dog moved.

**All move-up requests must be received by the deadline noted on the cover of this Premium.**

## ENTRY CONFIRMATIONS & JUDGING PROGRAMS

An email confirmation will be sent at the time of processing if a legible, valid email address is provided on the entry form. Additional confirmations will be emailed to acknowledge move-ups and corrections/changes (prior to closing). A final confirmation and the judging program will be emailed after the trial closes. If you cannot receive a Microsoft Word text file, or if you do not check your email, do NOT include your email address. Printed confirmations and Judging Programs are mailed to exhibitors without email addresses after the trial closes. **OWNERS/HANDLERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR REVIEWING ALL INFORMATION IN THE CONFIRMATION LETTER EACH TIME IT IS SENT AND CONTACTING THE TRIAL SECRETARY IMMEDIATELY IN WRITING (EMAIL) IF A CORRECTION/CHANGE NEEDS TO BE MADE. CORRECT AKC REGISTRATION # OR ILP # IS CRUCIAL.**

**NOTE:** If you have a spam filter in place on your email account, please add the trial secretary's email address to your accepted address list. If you are not receiving emails from the trial secretary, it is your responsibility to notify the trial secretary to reach a resolution.

Any exhibitor who does not receive the Judging Program within five (5) days prior to the trial, should contact the Trial Secretary. Always bring a paper copy of your confirmation letter to the trial. Corrections to the confirmation letter that are not brought to the trial secretary's attention at the time of receipt will render the database as the final authority for the day's information.

## ELIGIBILITY

**AGILITY:** This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained an AKC ILP or PAL number. Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners are also eligible to participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations, it includes both sexes.

**OBEDIENCE/RALLY:** This trial is open to all dogs six months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form.

### ALL ENTRIES:

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes.

## DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

The town of McKinney is about 33 miles north of downtown Dallas on U.S. 75/North Central Expressway. From the north or south: On U.S. 75, take the U.S. 380 exit and go west about 2.5 miles to FM1461. Turn right (north) on FM1461 and travel approximately 2.9 miles to County Road 166. Turn right (north) on County Road 166 and go .8 (8/10) miles to the site which is on the left. The county has posted directional signs to the Event Center.
