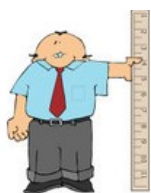

Check-In and Measuring Info

Check-in will start at 8:00 a.m. Saturday and Sunday and 7:00 on Monday. If your armband envelope is not in the self-serve box, chances are your dog needs to be measured. You may pick up your armband from the trial secretary after your dog has been measured.

Exhibitors are required to have a valid Official Jump Height Card/Valid yellow form for each of their dogs and must be able to present it at any time if requested during the trial.

There will be not be a Measuring Official at this trial. Measurements will not be official -- it will only get you through the weekend. All exhibitors who checked on the entry form that their dog needs to be measured must be measured before running (unless you're jumping 24"). If you are entered in Novice or Open, you do not have to get there early to check-in. It will be open all day. We will do measurements before either Novice or Open.

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running when necessary and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

CONCESSIONS!

Concessions will be open starting at 7:30 a.m. serving breakfast. Both fast food and restaurants are located within easy driving distance. **No other food or drink is allowed. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated. Use of Coolers: The use of small coolers is permitted for dog treats and dog food ONLY.**

MOVE-UPS

Be sure to let the trial secretary know if you've earned a new title since you entered the trial so your dog can be moved up! Pre-trial move-ups must be submitted to the trial secretary via email **no later than 6 PM Monday, August 29, 2011 at 6:00 pm.** Day-to-Day Move-Ups are permitted if you fill out a move-up form (available at the check-in table) and give it to the trial secretary at any time, but no later than 20 minutes after the last dog crosses the finish line on Saturday.

Arrival/Setup

Exhibitors are allowed to set up between 6:00 pm and 7:30 pm on Friday evening, at 7:30 am on Saturday and Sunday mornings and at 7:00 am on Monday morning.

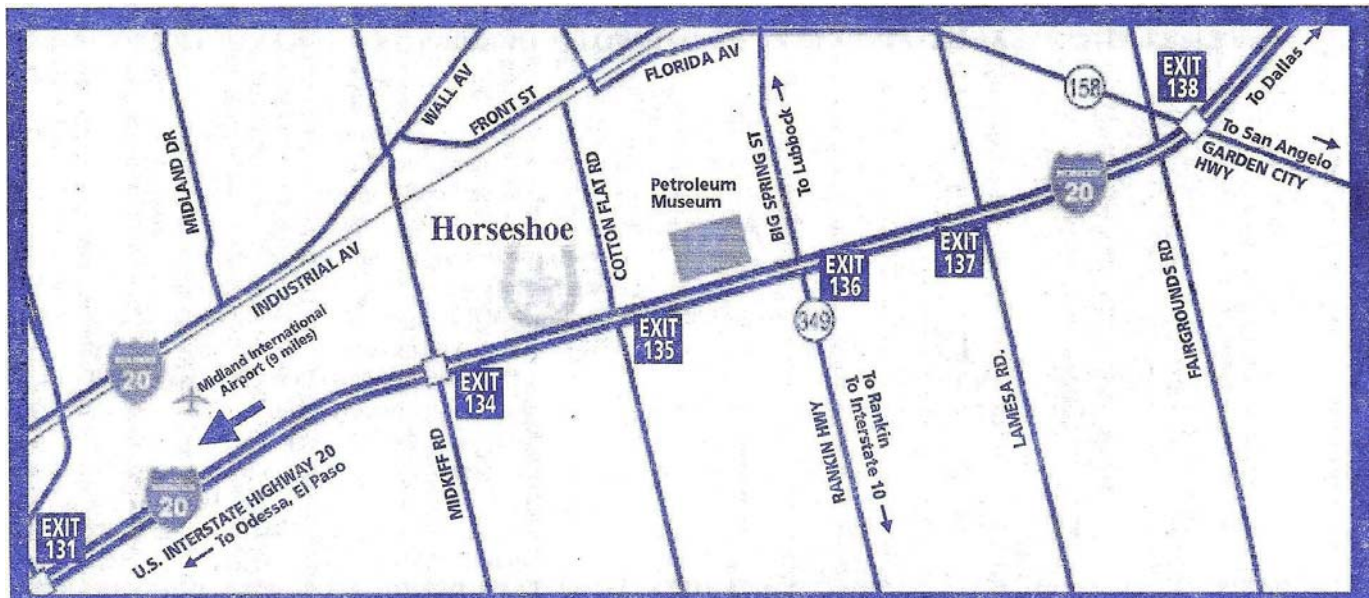
MAP AND DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL SITE
